



## 2025-2026 Children’s Class Descriptions and Schedule

Class and Age Range	Description	Days, Times, and Tuition
<b>Mini and Me</b> Ages 1-2	In this fun class for caregivers and their little ones, we’ll enjoy moving to the music and practicing skills like counting, learning the names of body parts and movements, and moving with a rhythm. Registration is for a carer/child pair (no need to register the accompanying adult separately).	Saturdays 9:00 – 9:30 am (Mini and Me is scheduled in 8 week terms. All other classes are scheduled for the full school year.)  \$100 per 8 week session
<b>Creative Movement I</b> Ages 3-4	Children have fun learning basic stretches and names of body parts while counting, working together, and taking turns. Students practice controlling their bodies while learning basic ballet and jazz movements. Playful music, engaging teachers, and an age-appropriate class length make this class a great introduction to movement. * Children must be potty trained to take this class.	Wednesdays 4:00 – 4:30 pm OR Saturdays 9:30 – 10:00 am  \$50 per month
<b>Creative Movement II</b> Ages 4-5	In this continuation of Creative Movement I, students continue to develop their understanding of musical rhythm and practice working together and taking turns. Students continue their study of basic ballet and jazz movements while adding jumps to their repertoire. Playful music, engaging teachers, and an age-appropriate class length make this class a fun way to enjoy moving!	Wednesdays 4:30 - 5:15 pm  \$75 per month
<b>Pre-Ballet 1</b> Ages 5 – 7	Pre-Ballet I begins with a review of basic skills (musical rhythms, taking turns, and basic anatomy). Dancers begin working at the barre, developing ballet technique, and stretching. Course elements include the history of ballet and ballet terminology.	Wednesdays 5:15-6:15 pm  \$100 per month
<b>Ballet 1a</b> Ages 7 – 9	The Ballet 1 series (Ballet 1 a, b, c, and d) focuses on elementary exercises with the goal of assimilating the diverse positions of the arms, legs, feet, head, and trunk of the body, and also on the development of basic habits of coordination and musicality. As students progress through the four levels, technique and artistry are developed and frequency of class attendance goes up.	Fridays 5:30-7:00 pm  \$150 per month
<b>Ballroom 1a</b> Ages 8 - 11	Ballroom 1a is an introduction to Standard and Latin dances, including waltz, tango, cha-cha, rumba, and samba. Students practice on their own and with partners, and all students learn to both lead and follow. Dancers learn to identify rhythms and music associated with each dance. As the levels increase, students learn more complex steps and challenging rhythms.	Saturdays 10 – 11 am  \$100 per month

<b>Modern 1</b> Ages 10 - 12	Modern 1 series students will be introduced to traditional modern techniques such as Horton and Graham. Classes include stretching, floor work, and moving across the floor.	Wednesdays 6:15 – 7:15 pm  \$100 per month
